Eligibility

- Registered as UPH Student and completed at least 2 semesters at UPH
- Approval from Head of Department
- Good academic records with minimum GPA of 3.00
- English Proficiency:
 - TOEFL minimum 550 (for Paper Based Test)
 - IELTS minimum 6.0
- Must have good record of credibility or behavior

Application Requirements

- Completed International Student Exchange Program Application Form ([Form 1](#)); **from HGU**
- Sealed Recommendation Form completed by a college professor or advisor ([Form 2](#)); **from HGU**
- Completed International Program Application Form – Outbound ([Form 3](#)); **from UPH**
- Recommendation Letter from Head of Department
- Copy of Academic Transcript
- Photocopy of the front page of your passport (must be clear and legible, minimum 1 year of validity)
- 2 portrait photos sized 3.5cm (width) x 4.5cm (height) (equivalent to 1.47 in x 1.77 in); must be taken by professional photographers and printed on professional photo paper

Expenses

- Room: USD 650 or KWR 670,000 (meal is not included. Students purchase meal tickets by bank card or cash. A meal ticket price ranges KWR 2,800 to 5,000)
- Books and Supplies: USD \$200 (estimate)

Key Dates

- Application due date: **October 1st** (Spring registration) / **May 1st** (Fall registration)
- Requested date of Arrival: Last Monday of February/ Last Monday of August
(*Please check the Academic Calendar for the confirmed schedule)
- International Orientation: One week before the semester starts
